Keeping safe

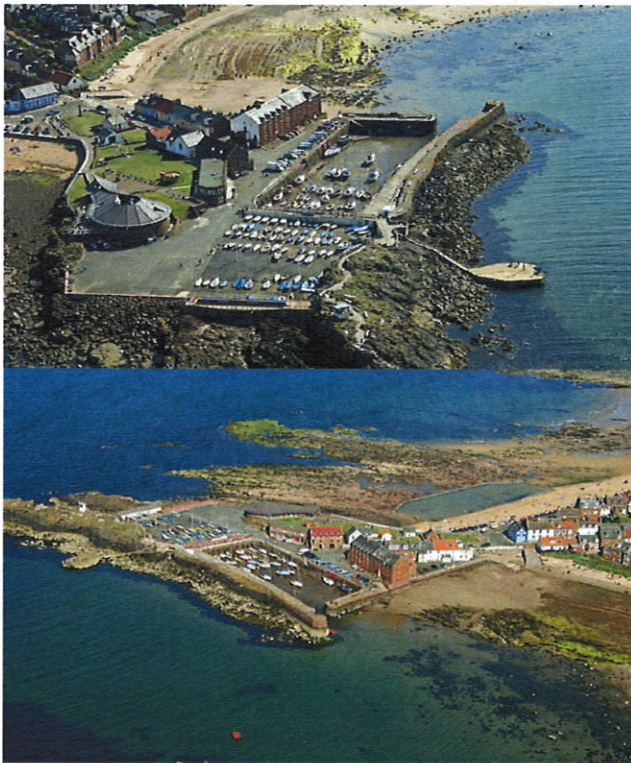
When jumping at the harbour you should always stay aware of your surroundings and others around you
